PART 1**PARKING**Section 1:

There shall be no parking of motor vehicles, of any type, on the travelled portion of all Town highways or in any way that will obstruct the flow of traffic or interfere with highway maintenance activities.

Section 2:

During the period November 1 through April 15 there shall be no parking of motor vehicles, of any type, within the right of way of all Town highways except with the written permission of the Board of Selectmen.

Section 3:

There shall be no parking of vehicles of any type on the north side of Becket Street and on the north side of Depot street within the areas posted NO PARKING.

Section 4:

The parking or leaving of any vehicle in violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

Section 5:

The fact that a vehicle which is parked in violation of this ordinance is registered in the name of a person or persons shall be considered prima facie proof that such person(s) was in control of the vehicle at the time of such parking.

Section 6:

Enforcement officers, as defined in 23 VSA Section 4 (11) are hereby authorized to remove and tow away, at the owner's expense, by commercial towing service, or by any means necessary in time of an actual emergency, any vehicle parked in violation of Section 1 or Section 2 of this ordinance or any vehicle the parking of which creates or constitutes a traffic hazard, blocks the use of a fire hydrant, obstructs or may obstruct the movement of emergency vehicles or interferes with the free flow of traffic.

Section 7:

A vehicle so towed away to a public garage under provisions of this ordinance may be redeemed by the owner of the vehicle upon payment of all towing charges, storage charges, or other expenses incurred in the moving of the vehicle. The operator of the commercial towing service may hold such vehicle until charges have been paid. The maximum towing charge shall not exceed \$35.00 and the storage charge shall not exceed \$2.00 per day.

Section 8:

If the owner of a vehicle towed under the provisions of Section 6 of this ordinance does not claim that vehicle within sixty days from the date of written notice from the Board of Selectmen that the vehicle has been taken under the control of the Board, the Board of Selectmen may by its order, declare the vehicle to be abandoned and upon the expiration of six months from the date of the order, title to the vehicle shall escheat to the Town of Williamstown. The Board of Selectmen shall sell

or otherwise dispose of such unwanted vehicle. Any proceeds realized from the sale shall be paid to the Town Highway Fund and shall be used for the purpose of enforcement of this ordinance

Within the six month period, the owner of the vehicle may redeem and be entitled to receive the vehicle, provided he or she shall present to the Board satisfactory evidence of his or her title and shall pay to the Board an amount equal to the cost including but not limited to the cost of removal and custody of the vehicle. If such costs are not paid by a person presenting satisfactory evidence of his or her title before the expiration of the six months period, the Board of Selectmen may dispose of the vehicle. The Board of Selectmen, in its descretion, may grant an extension of time within which the amount of the lien must be paid.

Section 9:

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance may be ticketed/cited for said offense by any enforcement officer, as defined in 23 VSA Section 4 (11) in the amount of \$5.00 for each day the violation persists.
