Carla Perkins gave a briefing on the Ford Property which included the quick-claim deed from the Agency of Transportation. We now have a copy of the deed and lot layout with right-of-ways for property owners. There are 3 monitoring meters of the state near the wing wall of the brook that will not hinder our plans for the monument.

Ed contacted Richard Reed from the Vermont Office of Veteran Affairs in Montpelier (828-3379) for site improvements, fundraising. He suggested we contact VT. Community Foundation for grants (Vermont CF. org). Also suggested was to contact VT Tech. College in Randolph for design work (landscaping) the state "farms" all this work out.

Earl will check with Northfield Legion: Fundraising.

The costs should be known for the stone base, cost of lettering on the monument itself, and for the stone pavers.

We have been contacted by Justin Parry (279-0664) of Barre Tile, Co. and Barre VFW. He will get information on fundraising and types & costs for stone pavers. (More to follow).
